Déanfar an tAthrú Beartaithe a ionchorprú in Imleabhar 2 de Phlean Forbartha Chontae Chill Dara 2023-2029 (arna athrú).

Cúis le hAthrú Beartaithe Uimh. 6 (Plean Lonnaíochta Na Solláin)

Cuirfidh an tAthrú Beartaithe Plean Lonnaíochta ar fáil do na Solláin chun teacht in ionad Phlean Ceantair Áitiúil Na Solláin 2016-2022. Cuirfidh an Plean Lonnaíochta creat beartais pleanála ar fáil chun forbairt inbhuanaithe na tithíochta, na fostaíochta, an iompair, an mhiondiola agus an bhonneagair shóisialta do bhaile Na Solláin a threorú amach anseo. Tá an Plean Lonnaíochta ag teacht le hordlathas uileghabhálach an phlean atá leagtha amach ar an leibhéal náisiúnta, ar an leibhéal réigiúnach agus ar leibhéal an chontae.

Notice of Proposed Variation No. 6 (Sallins Settlement Plan) of the Kildare County Development Plan 2023-2029 (as varied)

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 58(7)(b) of the Planning and Development Act 2024 (as amended), that Kildare County Council, proposes a variation to the Kildare County Development Plan 2023-2029 (as varied). The Proposed Variation will be incorporated into Volume 2 of the Kildare County Development Plan 2023-2029 (as varied).

Reason for Proposed Variation No. 6 (Sallins Settlement Plan)

The Proposed Variation will provide a Settlement Plan for Sallins to replace the Sallins Local Area Plan 2016-2022. The Settlement Plan will provide a planning policy framework to guide the future sustainable development of housing, employment, transportation, retail and social infrastructure for the town of Sallins. The Settlement Plan aligns with the overarching plan hierarchy which has been set out at national, regional and county level.

Contents of Proposed Variation No. 6 (Sallins Settlement Plan)

Proposed Variation No. 6 (Sallins Settlement Plan) of the Kildare County Development Plan 2023-2029 (as varied) will comprise a Written Statement and maps and is accompanied by:

- An Appropriate Assessment (AA) screening determination,
- A Screening for Appropriate-Assessment (AA) Report pursuant to the EU Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC),
- Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) screening determination,
- A Strategic Environmental Assessment Screening Report pursuant to the Land Use Planning - Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) Regulations 2025,
- A Strategic Flood Risk Assessment (SFRA) Report, pursuant to the Planning System and Flood Risk Management Guidelines for Planning Authorities (2009),
- A Settlement Capacity Audit (SCA), pursuant to the Development Plans - Guidelines for Planning Authorities (2022),
- A Surface Water Management Strategy (SWMS),
- A Social Infrastructure Audit (SIA).

Kildare County Council has undertaken a screening for Strategic Environmental Assessment in accordance with Section 58 of the Planning and Development Act 2024 (as amended) which determined that the Proposed Variation would not be likely to result in significant environmental effects. Therefore, the Proposed Variation does not require a full Strategic Environmental Assessment.

Kildare County Council has undertaken a screening for Appropriate Assessment in accordance with Section 58 of the Planning and Development Act 2024 (as amended) which determined that the possibility of any significant effects on any European sites, whether arising from the plan alone or in combination with other plans and projects, can be excluded. Therefore, an Appropriate Assessment is not required for the Proposed Variation.

How to Make a Submission



